Speaker Bios



Haroon Borat is Professor of Economics and Director of the Development Policy Research Unit at the University of Cape Town. He has served as an economic advisor to past Ministers of Finance, and holds the highly prestigious National Research Chair under the theme of *Economic Growth, Poverty and Inequality: Exploring the Interactions for South Africa*. Haroon is a Non-resident Senior Fellow at the Brookings Institution, is a Research Fellow at IZA, and an Honorary Research Fellow at the Human Sciences Research Council (HSRC). He is a member of the Board of the UNU World Institute for Development Economics Research (UNU-WIDER). Haroon sits on the World Bank's Advisory Board of the Commission on Global Poverty, and was Head of Research for the UN's High-Level Panel on the Post-2015 Development Agenda. He has studied at the Massachusetts Institute of Technology, and has a PhD (Economics), from Stellenbosch University.



François Steenkamp is a senior Researcher at the Development Policy Research Unit (DPRU), at the University of Cape Town. He has worked as a lecturer at the UCT School of Economics, teaching international trade and macroeconomics. François has a Masters degree in Economics from the University of KwaZulu Natal, and is currently working on his doctorate at the University of Cape Town. His PhD research focuses on South African export patterns and the developmental implications of these export patterns.



Wandile Sihlobo is an Agricultural Economist and Head of Agribusiness research at the Agricultural Business Chamber (Agbiz) in South Africa. He is a columnist for Business Day and Farmers Weekly magazine. Sihlobo has previously served as an economist at Grain South Africa (Grain SA), where he was mainly responsible for macroeconomics, grain market and international trade research. He also served as part of the secretariat of the Agri-Sector Unity Forum (ASUF) Land Reform working group. Sihlobo holds a Master of Science degree in Agricultural Economics from Stellenbosch University.



Nimrod Zalk is Industrial Development Policy and Strategy Advisor at the South African Department of Trade and Industry (the dti). Prior, he was Deputy Director-General of the Industrial Development Division of the dti. He also sits on the board of the South African Industrial Development Corporation. He has authored papers on a range of topics including: industrial development and policy, competition and competitiveness, and regional economic development, and has delivered lectures on industrial development and policy at the following institutions: University of the Witwatersrand, University of Johannesburg, University of Stellenbosch and University of the Western Cape. Nimrod holds an MSC in Economics (with reference to Africa) from the University of London's School of Oriental and African Studies (SOAS).
