




# Coal is the backbone of South Africa's energy system and highly concentrated in Mpumalanga








## NDC targets imply 60-80Mt coal reduction by 2030




- Imperative to address already planned mine closures (~12, Cole et al)
- 10 000 job losses in mining for low NDC range
- Assumes no export changes

## Coal power in net zero futures (ESRG 2021)



- Social exclusion
- Environmental damage
- Unremediated mines and future mines to close
- Dependent workforce and local economies
  - = pressing need for Just Transition planning and practice
- Lots of policy work South Africa is leading the developing world in this space
- Now urgently need to move to implementation

# Presidential Climate Commission: national Just Transition Framework



### Principles of justice

#### • Procedural:

Workers, communities, and small businesses must be empowered and supported in the transition, to define their own development and livelihoods.

### • Distributive:

The risks and opportunities must be distributed fairly

#### • Restorative justice:

Historical damages against individuals, communities, and the environment must be addressed, focus on rectifying the situations of harmed or disenfranchised communities; redress.

### Policy interventions

- social protection
- human resource development and skills development
- industrial development, economic diversification and innovation




