

UCT APC Professional Programme: Path to Success

To successfully complete the UCT APC Professional Programme, you must:

1. Meet Duly Performed (DP) Requirements:

- 1. Complete and submit all 3 Foundation Phase Assignments
- 2. Complete and submit the Group Case Study Assignment
- 3. Complete and upload the Mastering Professional Competence (MPC) submission
- 4. Sit for the June Mock Exam
- 5. Complete and upload the Recognising Professional Competence (RPC) submission
- 6. Complete and upload the Polishing your Professional Competence (PPC) submission

AND

2. Pass ONE of the Qualifying Exams:

August Qualifying Exam:

- If you are found competent/pass, you have successfully completed the programme (*provided DP has also been met*)
- If you are found to not be competent/fail, proceed to sit for the October exam

October Qualifying Exam:

- Compulsory if you **did not** pass the August exam
- If you are found competent/pass, you have successfully completed the programme (*provided DP has also been met*)
- If you are found to not be competent/fail, you have been unsuccessful with completing the professional programme and therefore not eligible to sit for your APC with SAICA
- You need to register for a full professional programme again next year

For your attention– If you meet DP requirements and pass the August Qualifying Exam; you can opt-in (*a sign-up form will be shared after the results are released from the August exam*) to write the October exam for extra practice (*at one of our venues and it will be marked*). However, should you fail the October exam, please know that this will not affect your original status of successfully completing the programme/passing.

Please take note of the following important requirements for SAICA APC eligibility:

- 1. Passed your ITC/IAC
- 2. Have completed at least 20 months of your training contract by the time SAICA releases the prerelease information for their APC
- 3. Have successfully completed a professional programme (as per UCT requirements for successful completion as per the above)
- 4. For CIMA members, you need to ensure you meet the criteria for the pathway agreement SAICA has with CIMA and have successfully completed a professional programme (as per UCT requirements for successful completion as per the above)
