Additional information:

- BUS3039 is not available to students who wish to pursue an Honours degree in Organisational Psychology. These students must take an alternative course at 3rd year level. Students may not register for both BUS2023S and BUS3039 within the degree programme.
- Places on the Law Courses in the 2nd and third year are limited. To be eligible for consideration for a possible (but not guaranteed) place, students wishing to apply to take Law courses in 2nd and 3rd year need to fulfil all the requirements as set out in Promotion Rule FBA16.
- Students may not register for PHI1025F as an elective if they have already completed BUS1036F/S
