


AfCFTA Capacity Building Training Programme for Government, Business, and Development Partners:

Training Overview

The AfCFTA Capacity-Building Programme for Government, Business, and Development Partners is a policy-oriented initiative designed to strengthen engagement with Africa's continental integration agenda. The training provides a comprehensive understanding of the African Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA) and its implications for industrialisation, trade facilitation, and investment promotion.

It brings together stakeholders from government, the private sector, and development organisations to explore how the AfCFTA can be leveraged to unlock provincial economic opportunities. The training further examines the alignment between provincial development frameworks and continental priorities, equipping participants with the analytical tools to integrate AfCFTA objectives into policy planning, business strategy, and intergovernmental collaboration.

Training Outcomes

- Understand the AfCFTA framework and its implications for subnational and provincial actors.
- Identify sectoral opportunities for the Eastern Cape and other provinces under the AfCFTA.
- Strengthen coordination between provincial, national, and regional structures on trade and industrial development.
- Develop a provincial AfCFTA Action Framework outlining key sectors, partnerships, and policy priorities.
- Build awareness of climate-smart and sustainable trade opportunities under the AfCFTA framework.
