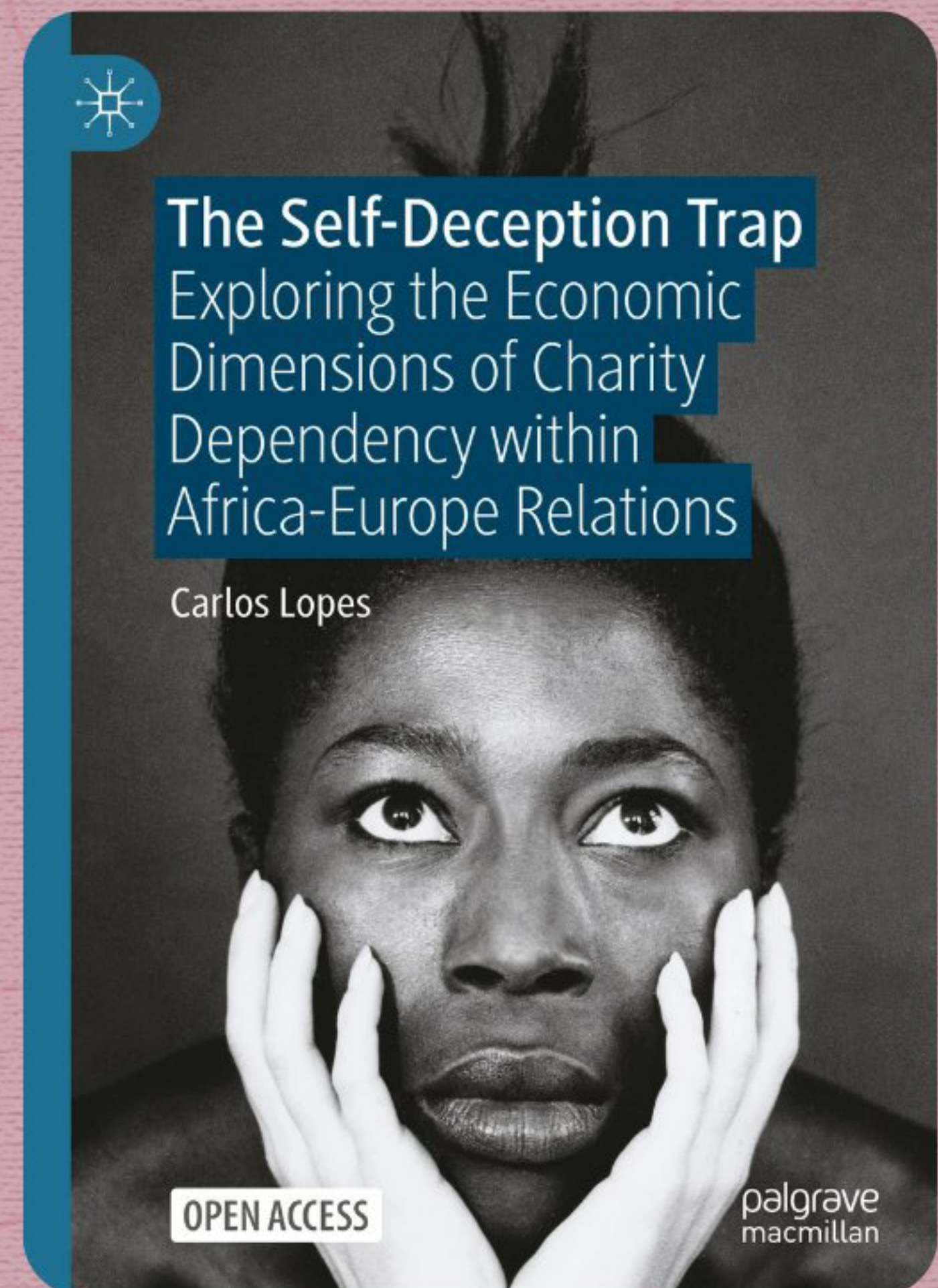
The Self-Deception Trap
